¹Generally, the first column in each chart gives a minimal description of the objects based on the best preserved inventory; objects are listed by number, locations by letter. (To conserve space, the first column of the Asklepieion, Sarapeion and Thesmophorion charts is the actual listing of ID 1417.) The other columns list the objects in each inventory, with their weight if given. In the majority of cases the order is identical in all inventories and so there is no need to give a rank number to the objects but simply to mark their presence in a given inventory with an x. Otherwise the rank order is done in the usual way. - = mostly lacking (identification not assured); + = weight incomplete. Weights differing from majority (or the first weight) are underlined; those not differing are asterisked. ** marks the end of a treasure.
