IN SUPPORT OF YOUR APPLICATION YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT:

1. **Official transcripts** of your academic record (graduate and undergraduate) from every college or university you have attended. If individual courses are not shown, please send a list with grades, signed by the appropriate administrator.
2. **Letters of recommendation** from at least three people who can speak specifically to your ability to successfully complete a graduate degree in the field in which you are applying, including at least one professor in your proposed area of specialization. Letters should be sent by the referees directly to the Graduate School of Arts and Sciences at the address below.
3. **A statement of your particular interest** in the field in which you are applying, the advanced work you have done in it, and your reasons for studying it at Bryn Mawr.
4. **Official scores of the Graduate Record Examination (GRE)**. For information see www.gre.org.
5. **If applying in Classical and Near Eastern Archaeology, History of Art, or Greek, Latin and Classical Studies**, a recent research paper or critical essay written for an advanced course or publication.
6. **If applying in French**, two essays, one in French written for an advanced undergraduate course or graduate seminar, and one in English.
7. **If applying in Clinical Developmental Psychology**, a description of your relevant research and clinical experience, areas of current research interest and future career goals. Please be sure to indicate the Psychology faculty member(s) whose research is of *particular* interest to you. 8. **If applying in Physics**, the results of the GRE Subject Test in Physics.
9. **If your native language is not English**, you must submit official scores of the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) or the International English Language Testing System (IELTS). Your application *will not be considered* if the scores are below the required minimums; for TOEFL: 600 (paper-based); 250 (computer-based); 100 (iBT); for IELTS: 7. Exceptions to the TOEFL/IELTS requirement may be made for applicants who (a) have lived in the U.S. for three years or more, or (b) have graduated from a college or university at which the language of instruction is English. You must provide proof of residency or a transcript.
10. **The application fee of \$50.00**. The fee is waived for McNair scholars and Fulbright nominees if they so identify themselves. Applicants for whom the fee poses a hardship may request a waiver from the Dean. No application will be considered until the fee has been paid or a waiver granted.
