LICENSE AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRONIC RESOURCES

KEY TERMS

AUTHORIZED USERS: Full and part time students and employees (including faculty, staff, alumni, affiliated researchers and independent contractors) of Licensee and its member institutions, regardless of the physical location of such persons, and patrons not affiliated with the institution but who are physically present at Licensee's site(s).

COURSE RESERVES: Licensee and Authorized Users may use a reasonable portion of the Licensed Materials for use in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by Licensee and/or its parent institution.

INTERLIBRARY LOAN: The Licensees may supply to an Authorized User of another library whether by post or fax or secure transmission, using Ariel or its equivalent, whereby the electronic file is deleted immediately after printing, for the purposes of research or private study and not for Commercial Use, a single copy of an electronic original of an individual document being part of the Licensed Materials. Licensee agrees to comply with United States Copyright Law.

PASSIVE ASSENT: Licensor shall not impose a “click-through” license on Authorized Users. In the event Licensor does impose such passive assent, the terms of this Agreement between the Licensor and the Licensee, in all cases, shall prevail.

USAGE DATA: Licensor shall provide to Licensee statistics regarding the usage of the Licensed Materials by Licensee and/or its Authorized Users in conformance with the Codes of Practice for Project COUNTER located at: <http://www.projectcounter.org/code_practice.html>.

CONFIDENTIALITY OF USER DATA: Licensor agrees to maintain the confidentiality of any data relating to the usage of the Licensed Materials by Licensee and its Authorized Users.

PERPETUAL LICENSE: Licensor hereby grants to Licensee a nonexclusive, royalty-free, perpetual license to use any Licensed Materials that were accessible during the term of this Agreement. Except in the case of termination for cause, Licensor shall provide the Licensee with access to the Licensed Materials through the Licensor’s standard interface by which access is provided under this Agreement. Both parties shall endeavor to agree to reasonable cost-recovery fees on an annual basis to render such means of access feasible.

EARLY TERMINATION: Either party shall be permitted to terminate this Agreement at any time and for any reason, provided that such party shall so notify the other party in writing thirty (30) days prior to termination.
