

## **ITEMS TO PRESENT FOR YOUR VISA APPLICATION AND INTERVIEW**

You need to present the following items at the nearest U.S consulate or embassy to your home country to obtain a J-1 visa to enter the United States. For more information on how to apply for a U.S visa and travel to the U.S, visit these links

- Bryn Mawr College Admissions Letter (Should have received from admissions, if not contact admissions)
- SEVIS generated DS-2019. Please sign your DS-2019 at the bottom of the page before presenting it for the interview
- Proof of SEVIS fee payment. Follow instructions in your packet on how to make payments. You have to show proof of payment before you can be granted a visa interview.
- Documentation evidencing financial ability to meet expenses while in the U.S
- Passport valid at least six months into the future
- Photographs
- Form DS-156, “Nonimmigrant Visa Application Form” (Consular office may provide)
- Visa fee (Consulate or embassy will advise of actual cost/fee)
- Any other documents required by the consular office
