

Post Arrival Procedures

After you arrive on campus, you are required to participate in orientation, which includes the following:

1. Mandatory immigration processing procedure at OIP

During International Student Orientation (ISO) all exchange students must meet with the Assistant Dean, Director of international Programs for **MANDATORY** SEVIS registration as required by Department of Homeland Security (SEVIS). Failure to check in with the Dean and to get registered into SEVIS can result in jeopardizing your J-1 immigration status! Bring the following documents and information to ISO for immigration processing:

- DS-2019
- Passport
- I-94 card (small white card stapled in your passport)
- U.S local address, and phone number
- Permanent address in home country
- Emergency contact information in the U.S

2. Mandatory Campus orientation and institutional procedures

During International Student Orientation (ISO) all exchange students will be assisted in processing the following:

- International payroll
- Social Security number
- Information on essential campus offices
- Health Insurance validation
