Summer Closing Information 2011

CLOSING OF THE RESIDENCE HALLS

ALL STUDENTS MUST VACATE THE RESIDENCE HALLS BY SUNDAY, MAY 15 AT NOON.

WHEN MOVING OUT OF YOUR ROOM, PLEASE BE SURE TO:

- Remove all personal belongings and trash.
- Check to be sure all College furniture is in your room.
- Close and lock the windows and door.
- Return your keys to Facilities Services in the Ward building or in a designated drop box.

FACILITIES SERVICES

Upon departure all rooms will be inspected. Fines will be levied as follows if areas fail this inspection*:

Room repainting due to graffiti, tape marks, etc.	\$50 - \$500
Messy room charges	\$25 - \$250
Messy common areas-to be assessed to responsible person, or entire floor/hall	\$50 - \$250
Missing Furniture	\$50 per piece to move
Room damages beyond normal wear and tear	Financed according to repair cost

**These fines represent typical charges. Should the cost of repair, repainting, furniture replacement, or other labor exceed these maximum amounts, the College reserves the right to charge the student(s) for full cost of repairs.*

KEYS

Beginning Monday, May 9 all dorm keys **MUST** be returned to Facilities Services in the Ward Building. If you need to return your keys outside of regular working hours (7am to 5pm, Monday through Friday) they should be placed in the drop box located outside the front entrance of the Ward Building or in the drop box located in the Campus Center. **Only keys issued by Facilities Services should be placed in the drop boxes - all other keys should be returned to the issuing departments.** Keys should be placed in an envelope provided at the drop box location. Please fill out the envelope completely including name, dormitory, room number and the number of keys being returned, seal the envelope and place in the drop box

KEYS RETURNED AFTER SUNDAY, MAY 15, 2011 BUT BEFORE THE LOCK HAS BEEN RE-CORED WILL BE CHARGED A LATE FEE OF \$25. FOR ANY KEY RETURNED AFTER THE LOCK HAS BEEN RE-CORED OR NOT RETURNED AT ALL THE FEE WILL BE \$50 PER KEY.

PUBLIC SAFETY

All students are reminded that during this busy time of year many thefts take place. Please do not leave any items of value such as, laptop computers, wallets, cameras, and book bags unattended. Report all suspicious individuals and activity to Public Safety immediately at 610-526-7911 or 911 for emergencies. ***Don't be a victim of opportunity theft!***

All bicycles must be removed from campus areas and bike racks or registered with the Department of Public Safety by noon on Wednesday, May 18. **ANY BIKE FOUND ON CAMPUS AFTER THAT TIME WILL BECOME THE PROPERTY OF THE COLLEGE.**

PARKING

Due to the Garden Party and Commencement activities parking will be restricted in key areas. There will be no parking on Canaday Drive or in the Wyndham lot from Wednesday, May 11 through Tuesday, May 17.

To prevent any cars from parking in the lot and impeding the setup for the Garden Party, the Wyndham parking lot will be blocked off. If your car is already in the lot at that time please contact Public Safety, 610-526-7911, for assistance in getting out of the parking lot.

Any vehicle parked on Canaday Drive or in the Wyndham lot after Thursday, May 12 is subject to be ticketed and/or towed at the owner's expense.

A reminder the residents of Merion, Denbigh, and Radnor Halls: ***Due to the large number of guests and increased vehicular traffic, no vehicles will be permitted into the Merion parking lot to load on Saturday between the hours of 1:00 pm and 4:30 pm.***

Please plan accordingly. Parking is always at a premium during move out. Please be courteous to your classmates and do not leave your car parked any longer than necessary to load. Once you have packed your car move it to a legal parking space, to allow others an opportunity to load up as well.

- ◆ A valid visa stamp in the passport
- ◆ A valid signature on page 3 of your I-20 or DS-2019 form
- ◆ A copy of your transcript
- ◆ Documentation of your financial resources for your studies

COLLEGE OPENING IN FALL 2011
