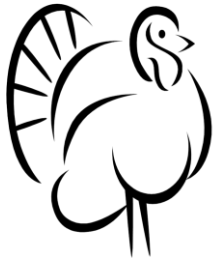


# BRYN MAWR COLLEGE

### RESIDENCE HALLS

## WINTER BREAK PREVIEW

All Bryn Mawr residence halls close Saturday, December 17 at 10am for Winter Break. Exam period ends December 16 at 12:30pm. One card access to dorms will be terminated at **10am on Saturday, December 17**. No student may have access to the halls for any reason during Winter Break. Residence halls will reopen Friday, January 13 at noon and the meal plan resumes Sunday, January 15 with dinner.

### A LIMITED AMOUNT OF WINTER BREAK HOUSING IS AVAILABLE FOR A FEE TO THE FOLLOWING STUDENTS ONLY:

- ◆ International students
- ◆ Students with 2<sup>nd</sup> semester classes at Penn
- ◆ Students participating in pre-season athletics
- ◆ Special circumstances – requires approval of student's Dean
- ◆ Any student with transportation issues is eligible to stay overnight in Merion on Saturday, December 17 only

Merion is the designated Winter Break dorm. Eligible students desiring housing over the break must submit a Winter Break housing reservation form, available online at <http://www.brynmawr.edu/residentiaallife/forms/>. Athletes need not submit forms as coaches will submit forms for the team. **The deadline for submitting Winter break housing forms is Wednesday, November 30 at 5pm.** Winter break housing is not guaranteed. Keys will be distributed on Tuesday, Dec. 13 10am – 4pm in the Campus Center.

***Any student with travel plans requiring her to remain on campus the night of Saturday, December 17 only must also complete a Winter Break housing form. Housing for this night will be in Merion and provided on a first come – first served basis. Students will not be permitted to stay in their own rooms.***
