

REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PSYCHOLOGY MAJOR AT BRYN MAWR COLLEGE
for Sophomores signing up for the Major in 11-12 or in prior years (typically Class of 2014 or earlier)

10 Units of Courses Plus One Semester Junior Brown Bag

- Psychology 101, 102 or 105 – Introductory Psychology*
- Psychology 205 – Experimental Methods and Statistics with laboratory
- 8 additional classes at the intermediate or advanced level
 - o Either:
 - 5 Intermediate Courses (200 level courses) and 3 Advanced Courses (300 level courses) OR
 - 4 Intermediate Courses (200 level courses) and 4 Advanced Courses (300 level courses) OR
- Senior Thesis for 2 semesters can be substituted for one 300 Level Class

*Students placing out of BMC's Intro course (by a 5 on the AP or a 6 or 7 on the IB or having taken intro at another College) are required to complete 10 additional full unit courses or their equivalent including a lab course at the 200 or 300 level (other than 205).

With approval, a maximum of two courses (or their equivalent) from Study Abroad OR from another University outside the BICO OR from AP or IB credit for Intro can count toward major requirements.
