Recruiting

- Build competitive recruiting classes, including the 2018 Centennial Conference Rookie of the Year, the first five First-Team All-Region players in program history, and the first two All-Americans in program history.
- Communicate with prospective student-athletes through phone calls, emails, and texts, author recruiting literature, and coordinate official and unofficial visits to campus.
- Organize and manage recruiting clinics including a Field Hockey Junior Day, Fall and Spring Clinics, and Mid-Atlantic ID Clinic.
- Represent Bryn Mawr at showcases and clinics, including APEX, GoodCo Sports, the Lineup, Super 60, and Top of the Class.
- Directed Revolution Field Hockey Camp at Bryn Mawr College, directing an overnight camp for 80 campers.
- Represented Division III on an NFHCA/SportsRecruits Recruiting Webinar (September 2024).
