### FINANCIAL AID REQUIRED FORMS:

#### CSS Profile® ([cssprofile.collegeboard.org](http://cssprofile.collegeboard.org))

- School code: 2049
- Required for institutional need-based aid
- Required from each parent when they are divorced, separated or never married
- We encourage you to provide your social security number or seven digit Bryn Mawr College Assigned ID to ensure accurate processing of financial aid results.

#### FAFSA ([fafsa.gov](http://fafsa.gov))

- School code: 003237
- Required for federal and state aid
- Electronically sign the FAFSA with the FSA ID, a username and password that confirms your identity.
- We encourage students and parents to use the IRS Data Retrieval (DRT) for a more seamless process.

#### Tax Filers (All necessary tax documents must be submitted to IDOC)

- Parent(s)/Stepparents: **Signed** 2017 Federal Tax Return (business and personal) and all applicable schedules and statements
- Independent students and spouse (if applicable): **Signed** 2017 Federal Tax Return (business and personal) and all applicable schedules and statements

#### Non-Tax Filers (All necessary tax documents must be submitted to IDOC)

- Parent(s)/Stepparents who do not file taxes must submit a Non-Tax Filer Statement along with all Federal W-2 forms.
- Independent students and spouse (if applicable) who do not file taxes must submit a Non-Tax Filer Statement along with all Federal W-2 forms.

#### Institutional Tips

- Report social security numbers and full legal names correctly. Without them, the U.S. Department of Education cannot process your financial aid results.
- Both the FAFSA and the CSS Profile are available **Oct. 1, 2018**.
