Snap-On Sensors

Propeller sensors attach to your existing inhalers. They automatically track how often you use your medication, and they can chime when it's time to take a dose.



Smartphone App

Information is sent to your smartphone, and the app learns more about your flare-ups and medication use over time. Propeller app can help you become an expert at managing your symptoms and identifying your triggers.



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Sharable Reports

Your care team can view this information, adjust your treatment plan as required and provide better care for your asthma or COPD.
