Overview

The Master of China studies is a

MA-level degree program with a strong focus on China's economic, cultural, and societal context. Zhejiang University Business School (ZIBS), partnering with the Institute of China Studies infuses business trends into the long-standing China Studies program.

Starting from 2021, preserving the original track of Chinese Culture and Society (CCS), a new track as Chinese Business Studies (CBS) will be introduced within the China Studies Program. The aim of CBS is to cultivate China's business expertise with global perspective and intercultural competence through a solid theoretical foundation and excellent business experience. The interdisciplinary curriculum allows students to work analytically, and to gain an in-depth understanding of China.

The MCS has a team of more than 30 professors from various departments and practical components of the program, such as workshops, field trips, and internships, engage students in the Chinese society to further prepare them for conducting independent research and to integrate empirical knowledge in daily life and work.



Program Details

Objectives



Through an interdisciplinary curriculum and in-depth field research in China's contemporary economic, cultural, and societal context, students gain a unique perspective on the social and business environment of China. China studies at ZIBS is built on the premise that international students should be able to interact and communicate with the local community by learning to speak Mandarin Chinese while pursuing their studies in English.

Format

The MCS students are divided into two types:

- The one-year stay joint-program for students from ZJU partner universities.
- 2. The two-year stay full-program for graduate students seeking to enroll independently.

Both programs require two years length of study. Students from the joint-program will return to their home universities in the second academic year.

Program Outline

The program is built on two interdisciplinary Tracks:

Chinese Business Studies (CBS) & Chinese Cultural and Society (CCS) both of which ensure that students acquire a broad understanding of contemporary China and issues related to its economy and practice of business.

Application

Application Duration:

From now on to March 31th, 2021

The following are requirements for admission to the MCS program:

- Bachelor's degree and above
- Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens in good health. Individual special cases will be reviewed separately.
- Candidates whose native language is not English must provide proof of English proficiency, such as TOEFL (90 or higher), IELTS (6.5 or higher).
- No Chinese language proficiency is required for the program at the moment.
- Students holding a bachelor's or master's degree from an English-instructed institution are waived from taking the IELTS or TOEFL.
