The main task of the Southern Black Forest Nature Conservation Center is to inform visitors about the Feldberg nature reserve and the Southern Black Forest region. Guests can find out more in the house itself in an extensive permanent exhibition, in additional temporary exhibitions and at the information desk. Guided tours, nature experience days, lectures and seminars offer a wide range of opportunities for all ages to get to know the Feldberg nature reserve better.

Another important task of the Nature Conservation Center is the management of the 4,226-hectare Feldberg nature reserve, including the implementation of maintenance and development plans.
