While most of the content has already been migrated to Drupal, the server is still in use by a small number of faculty and staff for various reasons, such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>•Course content and faculty/course archives</li> <li>•Microsites such as cities and iconog</li> <li>•Secure document server (e.g. – HR documents locked down by campus IP)</li> </ul> <p>In addition to the above, Web Services continues to use Bascom for various utility needs such as housing files and images for third party theming. Prior to retiring Bascom, decommission/migration strategies will need to be identified for the remaining content and a communication plan will need to be developed so faculty and staff have ample notice of the server's retirement.</p> <p>Web Services will need to consult with the Communications Working Group (CWG) to flesh out the communication plan as well as consult with EAST as Bascom's retirement could likely mean an influx of new DOOO users and/or new Moodle courses.</p> <p>The benefits of retiring Bascom include reduced overhead of having to manage themes and files in multiple locations and moving away from aging and frail hardware. TLR Archive	In Her Own Right	<p>In Her Own Right is a multi-institutional project managed by Temple University to create a digital collection documenting women's activism in the Philadelphia region from 1820 to 1920. The project is funded by a \$500,000 grant from the CLIR Digitizing Hidden Collections Project. As our contribution to the project, we are digitizing and creating metadata for approximately 1000 letters (10,000 digital images) exchanged between M. Carey Thomas and Mary Garrett between 1884 and 1894.
