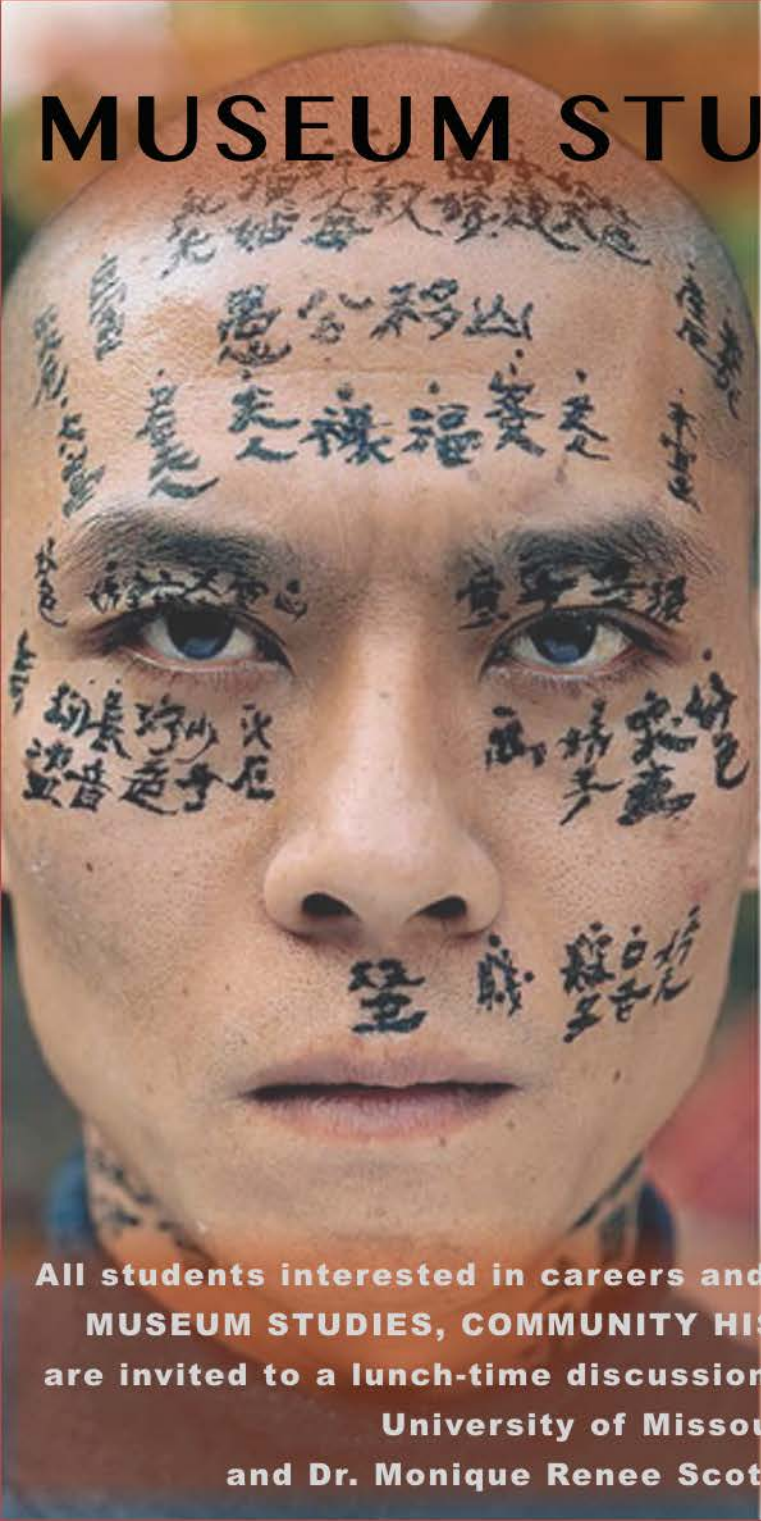


MUSEUM STUDIES LUNCH
